It was noted that free trees are available from NNC for planting commencing November; also, the <i>Branching Out</i> fund available from The Tree Council, and <i>Stobart Sustainability</i> fund for community environmental projects. Unlikely to take advantage of tree offer, as no suitable planting locations. Details of Stobart fund to passed on to other village organisations.

23.03	1. Clerk working on funding application to Office of Police, Fire, and Crime Commissioner Road Safety Community Fund for the purchase of a solar-powered sign. Will submit following Chair and Clerk meeting with NNC Highways and Kier on 8th September to agree locations of posts and to obtain quotes for purchase and installation. Cllr Cowdery has recruited volunteers to run the day to day operation of the device. Those available will also attend the meeting.
