2. MATTERS RAISED BY THE PUBLIC

1. Concern was raised regarding surface water flooding near Papley End. Cllr Cowdery reported that he had informed the North Northamptonshire Ward Councillors, who were investigating matters with the Environment Agency and North Northamptonshire Council. Cllr Brace advised that he had reported the matter to NNC and had been notified that investigations/work would be completed within either 90 days, or 180 days.
2. Mrs Carrie Walsh had recently planted the verge near the Village Hall with wildflowers, mainly primroses, and reported that daffodils planted in previous years, have increased considerably and are producing a good display. She asked for suggestions what else might be planted in future to augment the display. She will continue to volunteer as a biodiversity and nature representative of the Parish Council.
